WHEREAS, the alpaca fleece provides products that are warm, hypoallergenic, soft, durable but light weight;

WHEREAS, the last weekend in September as proclaimed by the Alpaca Owners and Breeders Association, Inc. as Alpaca Farm Day, the State of Indiana hereby makes it known that all Hoosiers should recognize and celebrate this special animal and join the Indiana owners and breeders of alpacas in their farm day celebrations; and
